- To be safe

- To be whoever and or whatever you want to be and to be accepted for who you are
- To be heard
- To be empowered and to speak your mind in the face of injustice
- To have freedom of expression
- To be free from exploitation
- To be free from any offensive, oppressive, or degrading language
- To be free from harassment of any kind including:
 - Physical or verbal harassment
 - Sexual harassment from adults or older youth
 - Anti-gay/bi/trans harassment
 - Harassment based on race, religion, gender, culture, nationality, age, or ability
- To be free from violence
- To have adults listen to you and stick up for you
- To ask questions
