

## JASMYN PROGRAM FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

JASMYN appreciates general operating funding to use where it is needed most at any moment. We offer other opportunities for funding specific areas of our work as well.

#### HEALTHY MINDS FUND

Supports services and resources for youth who have been rejected by family and other communities. These include:

- Care Coordination for youth experiencing homelessness
- Counseling
- · Health and wellness services

### **KICKED OUT FUND**

Supports services and resources for youth who have been rejected by family and other communities. These include:

- Drop-in sessions
- Scheduled appointments
- Referrals to partners for additional services

#### WHAT FEEDS US FUND

Supports JASMYN's meals program. We provide food at our on-campus program for youth experiencing homelessness and offer take away totes. Either way, it takes a village to feed young people, and this includes:

- Hot Meals Onsite
- Grab-and-Go Packs
- Meal/Food delivery to high-risk youth

#### YOUTH PRIDE FUND

Supports programs and events that empower and embrace. These include:

- Online programs for youth ages 13-18
- · Youth Development programs like teen game night and drop-in yoga
- Development of safe, in-person options for programs, events, and services
